You are developing an external Web site that lists the company's locations and executives.

You need to ensure that search results display documents that include the name Microsoft before other documents.

Which query should you use

A. `and(content:searchterm,filter(content:Microsoft))`

B. `and(content:searchterm,"Microsoft")`

- C.and(content:searchterm,rank("Microsoft",boost=100,boostall=yes))

5.Your company uses FAST Enterprise Search Platform (ESP).

You develop a custom Search Front End (SFE) that uses the following query:

content:searchterm

Document metadata includes a field named language that contains one of the following values: es, de, or en.

You need to modify the query to ensure that search results include only documents with a language value of en.You also need to ensure that linguistic processing and ranking do not apply to the language field.

Which query should you use

- A.and(content:searchterm,filter(language:en))
- B.or(content:searchterm,filter(language:en))
- C.and(content:searchterm,language:string(en,linguistics="off"))

6.You plan to install FAST Enterprise Search Platform (ESP) in a single-node configuration on a 32-bit Windows Server 2003 system.The server is not a member of a domain.

You need to ensure that the server meets the minimum requirements for installing FAST ESP.

8.You have a multi-node FAST Enterprise Search Platform (ESP) system.

You need to find out the status of all the FAST ESP processes, and you need to restart FAST ESP.

What should you do

- B.Run the nctrl sysstatus and nctrl restart commands from each server node starting with the

administration node.

C.Run the searchadmin status and searchadmin restart commands from the administration node only.

9.You install FAST Enterprise Search Platform (ESP).You plan to create a collection of files that are stored on the local file system.

10.Your company uses FAST Enterprise Search Platform (ESP).

You have a file server that contains a folder named Data.The Data folder has multiple levels of subfolders.The Data folder contains PDF files, Microsoft Word documents, and JPEG images.

You need to create and run a batch file from the Data folder that indexes only the PDF files and Word documents in the Data folder and all its subfolders to an existing collection named collection1.

Which command should you include in the batch file

A.filetraverser .-x doc -x pdf -c collection1

B.filetraverser -r /dir1 -s pdf -s doc -c collection1

C.filetraverser -r .-s pdf -s doc -x jpeg -c collection1
